Dear All,

This years English Police Boat Championships will be the only means of qualifying to represent England in the 2014 / 15 Home Internationals and European Championships. The reason for inclusion of the 2015 European Championship is due to the fact that this competition will be held in early May of that year and would perhaps be too short notice for persons who qualified to make arrangements to attend etc. The winners of the 2015 English Police Boat Championships will represent England in the 2015 Home International Championships.

This event will be fished 'Loch Style' in accordance with the International Fly Fishing Association (IFFA) rules.

The closing date for entries is **Friday 14th March 2014** however it is recommended that the entry form be completed and returned to me - electronically as soon as possible. Payment by cheque (made payable to the EPFFA) or by direct bank transfer is acceptable – the on-line banking details are available on request).

Competitor numbers may be restricted to 126 and in view of this entries may be dictated by a 'first come first served' basis.

All payments must be received by the closing date – anyone failing to do so may be de-selected and replaced by someone from the reserve list.

Should you require any further information please contact me by any of the means shown above.

Practice day boats must be booked and paid for by the individual in line with fishery requirements.

ITINERY & RULES

As previously indicated the event will be fished under the IFFA rules for Loch Style fishing and usual PSUK Rules. Copies of the rules will be provided to competitors in the match programme for information purposes.

All competitors must report & register their attendance between 08.45hrs and 09.15hrs that morning at the Fishery Lodge. A competitor's boat draw will be made at the time of registration to determine pairings and boat numbers.

A Health & Safety / Event Rules briefing will be held at 09.30hrs and the match will be fished started soon after and finish at 17.00hrs.

All competitors must be ashore by 17.05hrs for the weigh-in and register their catch. Nil returns must also be recorded.

Life Jackets / Buoyancy Aids must be worn at all times when fishing.

The match will be followed by the presentation of medals / prizes, light buffet and a raffle in the restaurant at the fishery.
